We will meet every Monday at 1pm starting September 14, 2009 at Centennial Hall.

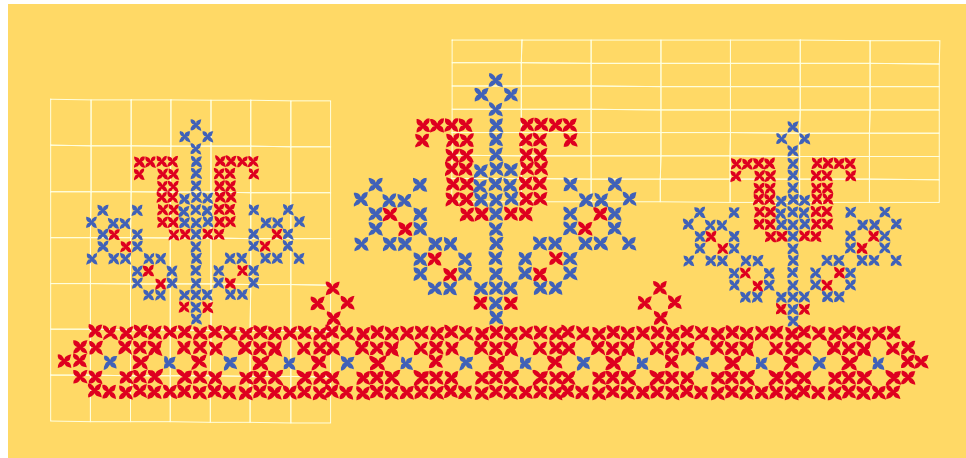
You can join any time, there is no charge, and you do not have to be a member of the Senior Center.
